"Good morning, dear numbers!" This is how preschool children all over Germany and in other European countries greet the numbers. Prof. Gerhard Preiß's Numberland programme playfully introduces children at the age of four years and older to the world of numbers.

The aims of the Numberland programme are to provide mathematics education for young children in a hands-on and fun way, to help children learn about the world and to make them aware of the relevance of this knowledge to their everyday lives. This innovative approach to early childhood education combines ideas from mathematics education with concepts from modern neurological research. This so-called "Neurodidactical" approach focuses on the child and his or her individual development. Activities take place in the **Number House**, on the **Number Street**, and in ten **Numberlands**.

Teacher Training

In this one-day teacher training you will be introduced into the basic concepts of Numberland and its theoretical foundation. You will get familiar with all the activities of lessons 1 to 10 of the Numberland Programme.

About Prof. Gerhard Preiß

Over the past 20 years Prof. Gerhard Preiß (emeritus of Freiburg University of Education) has developed new paths for mathematics education in early childhood and special education. The basic and innovative ideas of his projects stem from combining mathematics education with concepts from neurological research. This "Neurodidactical" approach focuses more on the child and his or her individual interests and talents than on the subject material. The aim of Prof. Preiß's work is to give children a broad and lasting basis for understanding mathematics and to support the development of the natural talents of each individual child.



About Numberland

Since it started in 2001, the Numberland programme has continued to attract interest in Germany and internationally. In 2003, cooperation with a world leader in educational services, DAEKYO, resulted in the successful implementation of the Numberland concept in the home school system in South Korea. Zahlenland Prof. Preiß Academy in Germany counts more than 40.000 participants at their Numberland further training seminars up to this year (2016).
